Theme Fogus

Resurrection of the Dead

Main Point: Just as Christ was raised from the dead, our bodies will also be raised, as immortal, spiritual bodies. This has been made possible because of Jesus on the cross, and how he defeated not only sin but also death.

Discussion Questions

Read 1 Corinthians 15:43-58

- 6. When someone dies, it is a human body that is buried in the ground. But the body that God raises up is a spiritual body. What do you think the difference is between these?
- 7. How can we be assured of all that has been promised? How can we be confident that when Jesus will return he will conquer death once and for all?
