Discussion Questions

Main Point: As brothers and sisters, we should provide gentle and loving support to one other. We are to bear one another's burdens, be quick to seek forgiveness when we fall short, and always seek to follow God's ways with a sincere heart.

Warm-up questions

1. Can you think of a time when you were in need of help and someone showed kindness and love?

Read Galatians 6:1-10

- 2. Do you think disciples should hold each other accountable? What does it look like to 'restore someone gently'?
- 3. How can we balance truth and grace when confronting sin in someone's life? Can you think of an example when gentleness was shown to you? What difference did it make?
- 4. What are some examples of burdens that you have seen other people your age carrying?
- 5. How might we practically help carry one another's burdens?
- 6. What is it important to examine our own lives before helping others?



- 7. How does pride or comparing ourselves to others hinder true community in the body of Christ?
- 8. Have you ever felt weary in doing good? What helped you press on?
- 9. How can we encourage others to not give up?
- 10. What are some simple ways we can 'do good' to others especially within the church family?

11. Can you identify someone in your life at the moment who God might be calling you to help? What things could you do this week to be a blessing and support to them?
