Filled with the Holy Spirit

Discussion Questions

Main Point: God's Spirit is a gift that can't be bought with money or magic. Simon learned that following Jesus means letting the Holy Spirit change our hearts, not trying to use God for ourselves.

Warm-up questions

1. What do you know about the Holy Spirit?

Read Acts 2:1-21

- 2. What is the significance of the Holy Spirit coming upon the disciples?
- 3. What does it mean to be filled with the Holy Spirit?
- 4. How did the coming of the Holy Spirit change the disciples?
- 5. What does the disciples' speaking in other languages reveal about God's purposes?

Read Acts 8:9-24

- 6. Who was Simon and what was his line of work?
- 7. How did the Samaritans react to Simon's sorcery, and what did they believe about him? How did he gain influence in Samaria?



- 8. What was Simon's reaction when he saw Philip preaching about Christ, and how did he respond to the Holy Spirit being given through the laying on of hands?
- 9. What did Simon want to buy from Peter and John, and how did Peter respond to his request?
- 10. What was Simon's true motivation to receive this power? What does Simon's attitude reveal about his understanding of the gospel and his relationship with God?

Application

- 11. What are some ways we can guard against seeking spiritual power or gifts for personal gain or self-promotion, rather than for God's glory?
- 12. How can we foster a sense of the Holy Spirit's presence in our lives and communities?
