Considered Time Strangely

Discussion Questions

Main Point: While others lived for festivals and important Roman days, the first Christians saw every day as part of God's plan to make the world new through Jesus. They believed God was already at work fixing the world and wanted everyone to know it!

Warm-up questions

1. What day/s do you most look forward to?
2. Have you ever had a day that unexpectedly turned into an amazing day?

Read Acts 3:11-26

3. Read vs 6-8, How was the lame man healed?
4. Who did the people think healed the man? How does Peter respond?
5. On the day when the man who couldn't walk was healed, people reacted in different ways. How did the man react? The people? Peter and John? (vs 11-12)
6. Peter reminds the people that in the past the prophets had foretold that Jesus would have to suffer. Why did Jesus have to suffer? (vs 16-18)
7. How did Jesus rise from the dead after he died?

8. What does Peter urge the people to do now - in the present?

9. Peter reminds the people that the prophets have already told them about a special future promised to them. What was this good news?

Application

10. If we believe this good news, what should we do while we look forward to it?

11. What does it mean to you that Jesus died so your sins can be forgiven?
