Discussion Questions

Main Point: God wants His people to do what is right. Following God means loving Him and loving others every day.

Warm-up questions

1. Should people be able to tell you are a Christian by the way you live your life?

Read Leviticus 19:1-18

- 2. What are the 10 Commandments? Can you explain how they are split into two different categories? (Hint: What do the first 4 commandments focus on; and the next 6? Read Deuteronomy 5:1-21)
- 3. Leviticus 19:2 summarises God's laws into two words. What are they?
- 4. What was the ultimate purpose of these commands?
- 5. Because God cared about the whole life of his people, the laws outlines in Leviticus deal with every aspect of living: including farming, marriage, clothing, animals, worship, and servant. Find some examples of this from verses 1-18.



- 6. The Law was not merely a list of special (or impossible) rules for a particular group of people, but rather the Law was a gift from God to the whole community about an agreed way of holy living. How does the Law demonstrate God's love for his people?
- 7. Which of these laws sound familiar or still bear influence in the world today? Which laws seem strange?
- 8. Do we find the Ten Commandments in the New Testament? What does Jesus say about God's commandments?

Application

- 9. How can we continue to live our lives distinctively from the others around us?
- 10. Who helps us live holy lives?
