# Discussion Questions

**Main Point:** Angels told shepherds that Jesus was born to bring peace to the world. His birth is good news that shows God cares for everyone.

### **Warm-up question**

1. When you look at nativity scenes what is your most typical emotional response? Scared? Worried? Peaceful? Joyful? Sad? Happy? Other?

#### Read Luke 2:1-14

- 2. As Luke introduces straight away in verse 1, the situation is anything but peaceful. Why?
- 3. What were God's people waiting for? Why were God's people so desperate for a Saviour?
- 4. Who did they think this Saviour might be?
- 5. God had send many people in the past to deliver his people. How was this rescuer different to the others?



- 6. While Mary and Joseph were in Bethlehem giving birth to baby Jesus, some seemingly random shepherds in a field receive a message from someone. Who was it and what was their message?
- 7. What is the significance of the angel of the Lord visiting shepherds and not a King, or other type of dignitary?
- 8. How would this 'Prince of Peace' bring peace in ways that people won't expect?

9. How can you know the last peace that Jesus brings?
