### Discussion Questions

**Main Point:** Fix your eyes on Jesus. In life there can be many things that distract us. Part of following Jesus is keeping our focus on Jesus, no matter how difficult things get.

### **Warm-up questions**

- 1. What are your big hopes and dreams for the race that God has set out for you in 2026?
- 2. What do you think could be some of the challenges that you will need to persevere with?

#### Read Hebrews 12:1-13

- 3. Why does it matter where we actually look? What tends to happen when we fix our eyes on things?
- 4. Who is the author referring to when they talk about the 'huge cloud of witnesses'? [HINT: It was be good to flick back to Hebrews 11].
- 5. The Bible compares living the Christian life to running a race. What does it tell us often stands in our way?
- 6. Consider a professional athlete for a moment. Do you know what their training regime looks like? How hard they need to work? How many years they train before they make it to the 'big league'?

- 7. Who are we meant to keep looking to for help? How is looking to him meant to help us? (We are told to keep our eyes fixed on Jesus. By reminding ourselves how much Jesus suffered, it provides us with hope during the times when we feel down, tired, despondent, or doubting our faith.)
- 8. How does fixing our eyes on Jesus help us to endure and persevere?
- 9. What is the reward we are working towards?

10. What are some really practical elements that you could integrate into your life next year (daily and weekly) to help keep your eyes focused on Jesus?
