#### **TEACHING TIME**

#### Together in Christ

We don't know much about the apostle Paul's family: the Bible doesn't mention a wife or any brothers or sisters. But he wrote lots of letters to different churches - and he often called the people in those churches his 'brothers and sisters'. Can you think why he might have done that? When he writes to the people in the church in Ephesus (where he lived for 2 years), he knows that some are Jews who have trusted in Jesus - but others are people who had been worshipping other gods and even the emperor. before they trusted in Jesus. But they were all brothers and sisters in God's family!

And Paul tells them something that we might think is surprising!. That God had chosen them to be a part of his family before they were born - even before the world was made!

How had God chosen them? He had planned that everyone who had trusted that Jesus died for our sins, and asked for God's forgiveness, would be part of God's family.

It doesn't matter what country we live in, or how good we are at school or sport, or what we look like. What matters is that if you trust Jesus, then you've been adopted into his family before the world began. You belong to his forever family where God is your forever Father and Jesus is your forever brother.

So now, you not only have your family here on earth - and they're very special. But you can also be part of God's family that lasts forever! That family will never end - they will always be your family. And it's all because of God's amazing love and grace.

With God's family, no matter how different we are, we are a family.

Look around at your forever family! Yes you all look different, some of us speak in different accents, we've all experienced different things, we're different ages,....but your church family is God's family and it is a forever family, because of Jesus.

Adoption is when a baby is specially chosen. God has especially chosen us because he loves us so much and he always has. - even before we were born!

7. Does it cost us anything (v8)?

No - it's all free!

When we talk about God's grace, we mean that God is so kind and generous that he's done everything so that we can belong to his forever family.

It means that you were specially chosen to be part of the family.

When you are adopted, you are truly part of the family - you have the same rights and privileges as every other person in the family.

Even though God knows all the mistakes we make, and sees the times when we are bad, he stills accepts us as part of his family!

5. How does this help us to understand God's 'grace'? We belong because of God's kindness and forgiveness - not because of anything that we have done. 5. How much does God's grace cost us?

God's grace is completely free. We can not earn it. Out of God's generosity, he sends us Jesus, so that we can be part of God's family forever.

6. How much grace does God give us v7-8?

God pours out grace on us. He doesn't hold back, but is rich and generous.

Point out the words like 'rish; and 'lavished' and 'poured out'

7. What is God's plan v9?

One day, everything in heaven and everything on earth will be brought together.

Why does God give us the Holy Spirit now v14?
He marks us as his own - it is the guarantee that we will live forever in God's family.. That's a promise!

# Letters from Paul - stickers

#### YOU'LL NEED...

- Alphabet Foam Stickers
- Printout Worksheet #1

#### STEPS


- Talk about how Paul wrote letters to lots of groups, encouraging them to stay firm in their faith. God's people in Ephesus was one group of people he wrote to so that he could encourage them to keep following Jesus.
- Give each child a copy of the printout and encourage them to use the alphabet stickers to stick letters all over their page.





Letter recognition comes before letter writing. This activity is a great way for children to play and form words using letters of the alphabet. Forming nonsense words is perfectly acceptable at this age!



# 'God's Family' Photo Wall

#### YOU'LL NEED...

- Printouts of large letters that spell 'God's Family'.
- Coloured pens/felt pens
- Electronic device/camera
- Printer or polaroid device

#### **STEPS**

- 1. Begin by taking individual photos of each child on the device and printing these to the polaroid (if you have this available).
- 2. Have the children decorate, colour. and cut out each of the giant letters. Display these on a large pinboard.
- 3. Then add all of the polaroid photos onto the board - showing a large display of all of the church 'brothers and sisters in Christ'.


## God's Family Chatterbox

#### YOU'LL NEED...

- Printout of Worksheet #3 (onto slightly thicker card is best)
- Scissors

#### STEPS

- Cut out the large square outline of the chatterbox.
- 2. Fold the square in half, from top to bottom.
- Open out the square and not fold in half, from side to side.
- Open out and turn the paper over (with print face down). Now fold each corner into the centre of the square, until all 4 corners meet in the middle
- Turn the page over and repeat step 4, bringing the 4 corners into the centre of the square to meet
- Fold the square in half to help assist in opening the chatterbox. Then fold in half again to make a square.
- Unfold the last two steps and now ease your fingers into the four openings at the base of the chatterbox, ensuring that the numbered sections stay folded inward.
- Push your four fingers together to form the closed chatterbox (looks a bit like a flower from above).
- Practise making the chatterbox move in and out before playing with a friend.





There is always a bit of a mystery and suspense surrounding what is hidden under the flap when you play with a 'chatterbox'. Ephesians reminds us however, that there is no mystery with God's love. We know and can be assured that God loves us, sent his Son to die for us, and that God wants us and chose us to be a part of his family.




#### **CHATTERBOX:** How to play:

Ask your friend to select one of the pictures shown on the top of the chatterbox (gift, heart, world, family). For each word displayed on this picture, move the chatterbox that number of times (e.g., the world picture has 7 words - God chose you before the world began - so you would move it 7 times.

Now the friend needs to select one of the 4 numbers shown on the inside of the chatterbox. Move the chatterbox that number of times (e.g., if they select 8 you move 8 times.

The friend again needs to select one of the 4 numbers shown on the inside of the chatterbox. But this time, open up that number to reveal a verse from Ephesians that you read to them. Repeat steps 1-3 as many times as you wish.







# Chosen and **Adopted**

#### YOU'LL NEED...

- Printout of Worksheet #4 (large fingerprint)
- Bibles
- Coloured pens

#### **STEPS**

- 1. Begin by talking about how unique God has made each of us. Talk about different gifts, characteristics, looks, and end with fingerprints.
- 2. Show the children the template of the large drawn fingerprint. Remind the children of Verses 4-5 that tell us that before we were born (and indeed before the world was created), God chose us to be a part of his family.
- 3. Have the children copy out verse 4 and 5 within the lines of the fingerprint template as a reminder that we are part of God's family chosen and redeemed

Ephesians 1:4-5





God has adopted us into his family - and chose us to be a part of this before the world began!.

# **GAME: Family** Memory

#### YOU'LL NEED...

• Set of Memory Game Cards (Feelings and Emotions), or similar. Sourced from Modern Teaching Aids

#### **STEPS**

- 1. Place ALL the cards face down and play a game of memory, trying to find the matching pairs of people.
- 2. Each player turns two pieces over to try and match a pair. If a pair isn't made the pieces are turned back over for the next player to have a turn.
- 3. If the pair is a match the player who made the match has another turn The player with the most pairs at the end, wins the game of memory.
- 4. Talk about the different people and how they are all different but if they are followers of Jesus they are part of God's family.

# GAME: Find the Family!

#### YOU'LL NEED...

- Printable character profiles (Worksheet #5)
- Scissors

#### STEPS

- 1. Cut out the character profiles. Ensure you have enough for one per player.
- 2. Shuffle the profiles before handing them out to the children
- 3. Ensure players do NOT show their card to anyone.
- 4. Once everyone has received their card, they are to move around the room in the manner outlined on the profile (i.e., qiving a 'queen' wave).
- When they find others doing the same action, they are to continue to move together, until all the members of that family group have been found.
- 6. Once seated as a family group, players show each other their character card and discuss what things they have in common that makes them unique and a special family. I.e., what is the one thing that they all have in common.
- Get all of the family groups to report back to the whole group on that one thing that makes their family special





Sometimes families are all good at a certain thing or all enjoy something the same. God's family includes people from all over the world, across all time, who look different, act different, are good at different things, but who all have Jesus as the common thread.






