Water into Wine

Discussion Questions

Main Point: When Jesus turned water into wine at a wedding, it was his first big miracle. Jesus showed everyone that he is God's Son and can do impossible things, pointing to his glorious kingdom.

Warm-up questions

1. Have you ever been to a wedding? If you were invited to a wedding, what would you most be looking forward to? How would you feel if one of the things you were looking forward to, was missing?

Read John 2:1-11

2. When Jesus and his disciples attended this wedding in Cana, what went wrong? Why was this a big deal?
3. When Mary found out that the wine had run out, why did she go straight to Jesus? Why not the servants, the master, or the bride and groom?
4. Remember that Jesus had not yet performed a miracle at this point. Why do you think Mary had confidence that Jesus could help?
5. What do you think Jesus meant when he said to his mother that the time was not right for him to show who he really was?

6. What two things did Jesus tell the servants to do?
7. What is the significance of the jars being those used for ceremonial washing?
8. When the master of the dinner drank this new wine, what did he say?
9. What does this miracle/sign show us about Jesus':
 - a) Kindness?
 - b) Power?
10. What was the disciple's response to this sign?

Application

11. How has Jesus' glory been revealed to us? Why should we believe in him?
