## Discussion Questions

**Main Point:** Jesus is always with us and has power over everything, so we don't need to be afraid.

### Warm-up questions

1. Can you remember a time you were feeling anxious or afraid? Who came to your 'rescue'?

### **Read John 6:16-21**

2. Where are the disciples going and why might they have travelled without Jesus?
3. What problem do the disciples face while they are in the boat?
4. How do the disciples react when they see Jesus walking toward them on the water?  
Why do you think the disciples were afraid when they saw Jesus walking towards them?
5. What does Jesus say to them? Why do you think those words matter?
6. What happens when Jesus gets into the boat?



7. Why do you think Jesus approached the disciples by walking on the water instead of calming the storm from far away?
8. What does this miracle show us about who Jesus is?
9. The disciples were terrified before recognising Jesus. Why do you think fear can make it hard to see what God is doing?

## Application

10. When life feels scary or uncertain, how can remembering who Jesus is help us?
11. Why is it sometimes difficult to trust Jesus in hard situations?

## Prayer

Dear Lord Jesus, Thank you that you are powerful over everything, even the wind and the waves. Thank you that you promise to be with us, so we don't have to be afraid. Please help us trust you when we feel scared or alone. Amen.
