Discussion Questions

Main Point: Jesus really rose from the dead. He is alive, powerful, and still lovingly cares for his people.

Warm-up questions

1. Have you ever had a day when something very unexpected happened?

Read John 21:1-14

2. How do we know that the disciples weren't expecting Jesus?
3. What happened when they did what Jesus had suggested?
4. Who first recognised that the stranger is Jesus? What did the disciples do then?
5. What details in this story show that Jesus is really alive, not just a spirit or idea?
6. Why do you think Jesus chose to reveal himself in such an ordinary setting (fishing and eating breakfast)?
7. The disciples had been unsuccessful all night, what might this teach us about relying on Jesus rather than ourselves?



8. Why is it important for Christians that Jesus physically rose from the dead? What difference does that make to our faith?

9. How do we see both Jesus' power and his care in this passage?

10. Do you ever find it hard to believe that Jesus is really alive? Why or why not?

11. What would you say if a friend asked you: Why do you believe in Jesus?
