Discussion Questions

Main Point: The Good News is about Jesus - God's Son. This Good News is for ALL people, everywhere.

Warm-up questions

1. What is the best good news that you have heard in recent weeks?
2. Other than Jesus, what is the best good news that you have been able to tell people about?

Read Romans 1:1-17

3. In verses 2-6, pick out the key words or phrases Paul uses to describe the Good News (the Gospel).
4. If you were asked to describe the Good News to a friend in one easy sentence, what would you say?
5. Why was Paul writing this letter to the Romans? Why was he eager to preach to them? (Hint: verses 7-13).
6. Who is the **source** of the Gospel? Who is the **subject** of the Gospel? What is the **goal** of the Gospel?



7. Why is it so important to recognise that the Gospel is fundamentally about God and not us?
8. Why does everyone need the Good News?
9. Who are the people in our community who need to hear the Good News?
10. Why is Paul not ashamed of the Gospel?

11. Are there times when you feel ashamed or embarrassed about sharing the Good News? What might help you become more bold in sharing the Good News?
12. Where will you spend most of your time this coming week? How will you pray and proclaim that Jesus is Lord?
