1. Have you ever deliberately done something that made your parents or teacher angry?
2. What do you think are some underlying motives behind disobedience?

3. What is sin?
4. Why does God get angry at sin?
5. Do you think we are at risk of recognising God but failing to worship him? How?
6. What does it mean to worship God?
7. When Paul wrote to the Romans, some people were worshipping statues instead of God (v 21-23). What are the things that we might think are more important than God?

8. What are some ways that sin can easily overtake our lives?

9. Re-read verses 31-32. What is so concerning about this?

10. Why do we need the Gospel?
