## Discussion Questions

**Main Point:** God is fair and sees everything, so instead of judging others, we should listen to Him and do what is right.

### **Warm-up questions**

1. Why do you think it's so easy to judge other people?
2. In what situations do you find yourself comparing yourself to others?

### ***Read Romans 2:1-16***

3. Why is it wrong to judge other people? How do you think that we disrespect God when we judge people?
4. How does knowing that God sees everything make you feel? (Encouraged? Challenged? Uncomfortable?)
5. Why do you think God is patient instead of judging people straight away?
6. In v11-16, Paul talks about how the Jewish people were given the law - and the Gentiles (non-Jews) did not receive the law from God in the same way that the Jews did. Why is v15 so important?



7. Also in v11-16, Paul explains that there is a big difference between hearing (or knowing about) God's law and doing God's law. What do you think he meant?
8. Why is v16 such good news?

## Application

9. What does it look like to take responsibility for your own heart instead of focusing on others?
10. What is one practical way you can "listen to God and do what is right" this week?

Heavenly Father, Thank you that you are perfectly just and that nothing is hidden from you. Please forgive us when we judge others while ignoring our own sin.
