Discussion Questions

Main Point: Adam brought sin and death but Jesus brings forgiveness and life.

Warm-up questions

1. Have you ever seen something get spoiled? Or owned something that got broken?

Read Romans 5:12-21

2. God was really sad when His world was spoiled by sin. Recap how this happened?

3. Read v 12-14. How does the sin of one man (Adam) affect us today? How are these effects of sin so apparent in our world?

4. Why do you think we choose to do wrong even when we know it's wrong?

5. Who is the other 'one man' in v15-16? And what gift does he bring?

6. Read v 17. When people receive the gift of grace from Jesus, what 2 privileges do they discover this gift 'contains'.

7. Jesus is the one man who reversed the effect of sin. How is Adam the opposite of Jesus? (*Hint: think of what Adam brings and what Jesus brings. e.g., Sinful - sinless;*



imperfect - perfect; disobedient - obedient; death forever - life forever).

8. In v 19, Paul says that one man DISOBEYED and one man OBEYED. If Adam disobeyed God by believing the serpent's lies and sinning, how did Jesus obey God?
9. What difference will it make to you this week, to know that you have accepted God's gift of grace?

Application

10. If someone asked you: "What is so amazing about God's grace?" what would you say?

Gracious Father, we praise you that our sin does not have the final word, but that by believing in your Son we can know forgiveness and life. Amen.
