## Discussion Questions

**Main Point:** Because of Jesus, sin is no longer 'boss' of our lives. We are completely free and have been given a new life to live for God.

### Warm-up questions

1. Have you ever deliberately done something that made someone angry?
2. What do you think are some underlying motives behind disobedience?

### ***Read Romans 6:1-23***

3. There are only two ways to live, either as "slaves of sin" or as "slaves of obedience." No matter how you live, you are enslaved to something. Where does each of these ways of living lead? In what ways have you seen sin lead to more sin?
4. In what ways were we slaves to sin and how have we been set free from sin?
5. What steps can we take to be dead to sin v9-11?
6. When God is our master, what is the free gift that he gives us v23?



7. If God has given us eternal life (and peace and hope and forgiveness), does the question that Paul asks in v1 make sense? (Look at vs2-5 to see Paul's thoughts on this!)
8. In what ways can we use grace as a license for sin? Why do you think we are so prone to justify our sin?

## Application

9. How might people around you (family, classmates etc) know whether that God (not sin) is your master?
10. How could you better worship God this week with your whole life?
