Discussion Questions

Main Point: Because of Jesus, God's Spirit helps us live as God's children.

Warm-up questions

1. Have you ever heard the phrase 'being born again'? What might this mean?

Read Romans 8:9-15

2. How does Romans 8:9 define the presence of the Holy Spirit in believers?
3. How can we be sure that God has given us His Spirit?
4. Becoming a Christian means 'sin' is no longer the most powerful influence in your life. What distinguishes those "in the Spirit" from those "in the flesh"?
5. Everyone in God's family is expected to live under the power of the Spirit. What might this look like in your life?
6. Being adopted isn't something that just 'happens' naturally. It describes something that is done deliberately, acquired through choice. Does knowing that God desires to adopt you, through His spirit, encourage you?

7. What does Romans 8:14 mean by "led by the Spirit of God"?
8. How does understanding our identity as "children of God" impact the way we view ourselves and our relationship with God?

9. How can we ensure we are living according to the Spirit daily?
10. What practical steps can you take to align your life with the Holy Spirit?
