## Discussion Questions

**Main Point:** Jesus brings people together to love, serve, and care for one another.

### Warm-up questions

1. Can you name some gifts God gives His people?

### ***Read Romans 12***

2. What does it mean to be a 'living sacrifice'? What parts of our lives does this affect?
3. What are some of the ways in which we should and shouldn't conform to the pattern of the world?
4. Romans 12 describes Christians as being like one body with many different parts. What do you think that means for the church?
5. Can you think of any practical examples of when you have seen the body of Christ at work and it's worked really well? What about when it's worked very poorly?
6. What do you think it means to "honour one another above yourselves" (Romans 12:10)?
7. Why can it sometimes be difficult to put other people's needs before our own?

8. How does knowing that Jesus has already loved and served us change the way we should treat other people?

9. Think about your own gifts and abilities. How could you use them to serve or encourage others?

10. What is one thing you could do this week to love, serve or care for someone else?
