Discussion Questions

Main Point: Ezekiel saw an incredible vision from God, and it showed him how amazing and powerful God is. Ezekiel's vision shows us that God is always with us and He is in control.

Warm-up questions

1. What do you think God is like?

Read Ezekiel 1:4-28

2. Ezekiel's vision was pretty strange! What do you think would have been your first reaction if you had seen what Ezekiel saw?
3. Why do you think God gave Ezekiel such a spectacular and overwhelming vision of Himself?
4. What was happening to God's people at the time Ezekiel received this vision?
5. Why might the Israelites have been tempted to think that God had abandoned them?
6. Can you name some of the things that Ezekiel described and what each one represents?

7. Ezekiel responded to seeing God's glory by falling facedown. What does worship and obedience look like for us today?
8. Why is it okay that there are things about God or the Bible that we don't completely understand?

Application

9. Have you ever experienced a time when it felt like God was far away or wasn't in control?
10. How can knowing that God is present and in control change the way we respond when life is difficult?
